BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORY NOTE:

Born in Boston, Massachusetts, George B. Seitz was an actor, playwright, screenwriter, and director in the 1920s, 30s and 40s, working at Columbia Pictures and Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer (MGM). Seitz is the father of George B. Seitz Jr, a writer/director of film and television in the 1940s and 1950s. George Seitz died in 1944 in Hollywood, California.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The collection consists of 1 box of materials relating to three Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer (MGM) films directed by George B. Seitz in 1937 and 1938, UNDER

THE COVER OF NIGHT (1937), YOU'RE ONLY YOUNG ONCE (1937), AND YELLOW JACK (1938). Film titles are referenced by working titles in several documents, UNDER THE COVER OF NIGHT is referred to as "Murder for Profit" and YOU'RE ONLY YOUNG ONCE as "A Family Vacation." Records are comprised of scripts, correspondence and memoranda, cast, crew, and production notes, research recommendations, and newspaper clippings.
