BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Stuart Cornfeld was born in Los Angeles, California on November 13, 1952 and gained a Bachelor's Degree in psychology from the University of California, Berkeley before returning to his hometown to attend the American Film Institute. While at the AFI Conservatory, Cornfeld focused on the producing discipline and worked on actress Anne Bancroft's Directing Workshop for Women film *FATSO* (1976), and later was introduced to her husband, comedian and filmmaker Mel Brooks. After graduating from AFI in 1975, Cornfeld assisted at Brooksfilms, where he had the opportunity to work as a producer on *THE ELEPHANT MAN*. It was Cornfeld who suggested to Brooks that fellow AFI alumni David Lynch should helm as director of the film, the success of which boosted both of their careers significantly.

From there, Cornfeld went on to produce many notable works, such as Steven Soderberg's *KAFKA* (1990), Guillermo Del Toro's *MIMIC* (1997), and the iconic, genre defining body horror feature, *THE FLY* (1977) by David Cronenberg. Then, in 1999 Cornfeld shifted gears to focus primarily on comedy, where he teamed up with Ben Stiller to cofound Red Hour Films. Together they produced a series of successful features, such as *ZOOLANDER* (2001), *TENACIOUS D IN THE*

PICK OF DESTINY (2006) and TROPIC THUNDER (2008). Cornfeld also occasionally appeared as an actor in films, most notably as the Pirate King in FAST TIMES AT RIDGEMONT HIGH, directed by AFI classmate and longtime collaborator Amy Heckerling. In 1986, he married Los Angeles based performance artist Johanna Went, though they later divorced. Cornfeld died in 2020 from cancer and was survived by two sisters, Lois and Elena.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The Stuart Cornfeld Papers span 1952-2015, and are comprised of various materials, including photographs, production documents, concept art, costume design, scripts, audiovisual materials, casting materials, as well as publicity, press clippings, personal items and ephemera. The collection is arranged into nine main series; (1) Film and Television which contains subseries of the films THE FLY, KAFKA, MIMIC, TENACIOUS D IN THE PICK OF DESTINY, and the television series FALLEN ANGELS, all of which were given emphasis due to the greater amount of material included within the collection. Materials within this series were arranged by the chronological stages of production, in order to show the evolution of a work from beginning stages to completion, to publicity, and ongoing legacy.

The following series, (2) Scripts, are arranged by alphabetical order, and split between Stuart Cornfeld projects, both realized and unrealized, and other scripts which he had in his collection but did not himself produce. Series (3) Production Documents, (4) Photos, (5) Press, (6) Other Print, and (7) Personal are all arranged by type and then in alphabetical order. Series (8) Oversized is arranged with the primary concern of item size/dimensions and storage needs, and within this is further sorted by type and in alphabetical order. The final series (9) Media, is divided between types of audiovisual materials, namely audiocassettes and video, which are both arranged by alphabetical order. These materials are stored separately from print materials, in the Productions Archive.
